Commissioner Morrissey's Quarterly Quote:



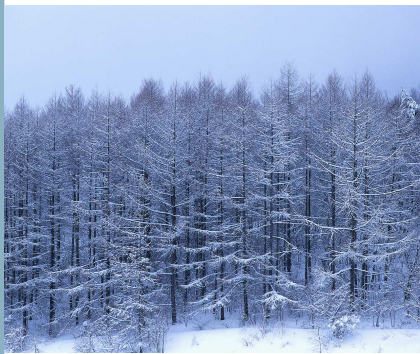
Greetings,

A true sign that winter is almost over occurred recently and it is not related to the groundhog in Pennsylvania. Last week, the Red Sox Spring Training Truck pulled out of Fenway Park en route to Florida filled with all of the supplies necessary to get the Boston Red Sox World Series ready!

Another sign that winter is coming to a close are the Spring events taking place at the State House. These initiatives include the development of the 2007 budget by the Governor and Legislature and the planning for both MR/DD Month in March and Autism Awareness Month in April.

Despite the recent Nor'easter, the Autism Division has not spent anytime in hibernation—instead, there has been a flurry of activity. The Autism Support Centers each received new fiscal resources to help develop staff capacity and to create various programs and camps for children that will take place between now and the end of June. Through the Division's RFR Mini-Grant Process, 27 organizations from across the Commonwealth received funding totaling \$250,000 to implement a variety of programs for children and their families. These programs will reach families in communities from Pittsfield to Martha's Vineyard. - The **First Responder Training Initiative** is moving ahead thanks in large part to the efforts of those at South Norfolk County Arc's Family Autism Center, The Autism Resource Center in Central MA, the Autism Alliance of MetroWest and the Autism and Law Enforcement Education Coalition (ALEC) an effort initiated by the Norfolk County District Attorney's Office.
- The **Pediatrician Awareness Project** is gearing up for a late Spring Continuing Medical Education (CME) Course with a focus on using various diagnostic screening tools to help with early identification of developmental disabilities, especially autism.
